Planning application submitted for Thackson's Well Wind Farm

The planning application for a wind energy project at Long Bennington, Lincolnshire, has been submitted by Infinergy to South Kesteven District Council on Friday 30th November 2007.

The project is known as Thackson's Well Wind Farm. Over the past year Infinergy conducted an environmental impact assessment which included investigations such as how the construction and operation of the wind farm will affect ecology, birds, archaeology, hydrology, traffic, aviation, TV and mobile phone reception, landscape and nearby residents.

The proposed renewable energy scheme comprises 10 wind turbine generators, which will generate enough safe, clean, sustainable electricity equivalent to the annual consumption of up to 12,800 households (around 25% of all the households in the South Kesteven local authority area). It will also displace up to 52,000 tonnes of the greenhouse gas Carbon Dioxide (CO₂) from entering the atmosphere annually which will be a significant contribution from South Kesteven to tackle climate change.

The Environmental Statement is available for public viewing at South Kesteven District Council offices in Grantham. Long Bennington Parish Office and Bottesford Library will also be provided with all ES documents.
