Wind farm developer Infinergy opens Scottish office in Inverness

With a large part of its project portfolio in Scotland, Infinergy felt a need to have a Scottish presence. The company has now opened a Scottish office in Inverness.

As well as the Ross-shire wind farm which received consent from the Scottish Government in 2008, the company has applications in the planning system for a wind farm on Cawdor Estate, near Dunoon in Argyll and near Dufftown in Moray.

The office at Beechwood Business Park is headed up by Senior Project Manager Mark van Rij.

He commented: "As a company we are doing a lot of work in Scotland with the various wind farms which have either had planning consent or are at some stage in the planning process.

We needed to have people on the ground in Scotland and we felt that Inverness was a good location. It's a fantastic part of the world and we are delighted to have the chance to live here."

Infinergy has a commitment to using local suppliers and services wherever possible. As Mark van Rij explained, it also gives them closer access to local communities: "We are consulting with a number of communities in relation to our planning applications and communication is much easier now I am living in the local area."

In December 2008 the Scottish Government granted Infinergy planning permission for the construction of the 17 turbine Lochluichart Wind Farm with an installed generating capacity of 51 megawatts. The company awaits decisions on the 177 MW Dorenell Wind Farm project on the Glenfiddich Estate and the 20 MW Dunoon Wind Farm on the Cowal peninsula in Argyll. This June Infinergy submitted the planning application for the 39 MW Tom nan Clach Wind Farm on Cawdor Estate.

Infinergy has its headquarters in Wimborne, Dorset and has recently set up a Welsh office in Pembroke Dock. The company is a full subsidiary of KDE Energy, a Dutch renewable energy business which develops, constructs and operates onshore wind projects across Europe.
